

## Environmental Policy

- Maintaining emergency response arrangements to minimise environmental harm in the event of spills, vehicle incidents or equipment failure;
- Complying with all environmental legislation, licences, approvals and client environmental management requirements applicable to our operations;
- Providing training and information to workers and contractors so they understand environmental hazards, controls and reporting requirements;
- Requiring contractors and suppliers to meet Cropline Group's environmental standards and to manage environmental risks arising from their activities;
- Minimising waste and improving resource efficiency through waste segregation, recycling where practicable, efficient fuel use and continual improvement of operational practices;
- Setting, monitoring and reviewing measurable environmental objectives and performance indicators to support continual improvement;
- Encouraging the prompt reporting of environmental incidents, near misses and hazards, and ensuring appropriate investigation and corrective actions are implemented.

Cropline Group Pty Ltd expects all workers and contractors to take reasonable care to prevent environmental harm, to follow environmental procedures, and to report any actual or potential environmental impacts immediately.
